Tournament Selection

1. The team in each conference with the best overall win/loss regular season record will be the conference champions (No plaque). The conference champions will host first round regardless of record.
2. The remaining four tournament teams will be selected by the two best win/loss records of non-conference champions in the East/South scheduling cluster and the two best from the North/West scheduling cluster. (8 teams; 4 teams per 2 brackets, winners advancing to finals).
3. The four conference champions will be seeded first or second according to win/loss record against common opponents. *The remaining teams will be seeded third or fourth according to win/loss record against common opponents.* (Ex.: in East/South 1v4, 2v3; North/West 1v4, 2v3)

The semifinal round is played versus common opponents. *Winner of E/S 1v4 plays winner of E/S 2v3; winner of N/W 1v4 plays winner of N/W 2v3

*Common opponents for the 2018 season are: East/South conferences and North/West conferences

Seeding for Finals

The Football Point Rating System will be utilized to seed the two final teams in Division I based on their record through the semifinal round.
