

BEDFORD HIGH SCHOOL

From the Intersection of Route 114 and Route 101 in Bedford

- Follow Route 101 West to the blinking yellow light.
- Turn left onto Nashua Road.
- Bedford High School will be approximately 1/4 mile on your right.

EXETER HIGH SCHOOL – WILLIAM BALL STADIUM

1 Blue Hawk Drive (for GPS use 315 Epping Road)

- From North/West (Manchester Area) Route 101 East to Exit 8, Brentwood. At the top of the ramp turn left. Go over overpass to stop sign. At stop sign, turn right onto Route 27E/Epping Road. High School Entrance is 1.2 miles down on the left. Stadium is located behind the school.
- From East (Portsmouth Area) Route 101 West to Exit 9, Route 27 Exeter. At the top of the ramp turn right. High School entrance will be a few miles down on right. Stadium is located behind the school.

DARTMOUTH COLLEGE, HANOVER, NH

From the Boston area (~2.5 hours):

- Take I-93 north to I-89 north at Concord, N.H.
- Get off I-89 at Exit 18 in Lebanon, N.H. onto Route 120. (A sign says that it is the exit for Dartmouth College.)
- Bear right off the exit, heading north on Rt.120 into Hanover.
- 4.1 miles from the exit, Rt. 120 forks at a traffic light.
- Bear right at the fork, following Rt. 120 one-half mile on South Park Street to the second traffic light.
- Turn left at the light, onto East Wheelock Street.
- Follow East Wheelock for two-tenths of a mile, when you will come to the Hopkins Center (left) and the Dartmouth Green (right).

From Burlington, Vt. (~1.5 hours):

- Take I-89 south to I-91 north in White River Junction, Vt. See following description.

From New York (~5 hours), southern New England and points south:

- Take I-91 north to exit 13 at Norwich, Vt.
- Bear right off the exit, across the Ledyard Bridge spanning the Connecticut River.
- Continue up the hill (West Wheelock Street) to the top of the hill and to the traffic light in the center of town - nine-tenths of a mile from the interstate exit.
- To your left at the light is the Dartmouth Green; to your right is the Hanover Inn.

DERRYFIELD PARK - MANCHESTER, NH

I-89 south to the end; then take I-93 south. After the toll booth stay right on I-93 south to Exit 8 (Wellington Road). Go towards Manchester, and when Wellington Road crosses Route 28A and intersects Bridge Street, you will see the park on your right.

EVERETT ARENA, CONCORD, NH

- From the North. Take 93 South to exit 14 in Concord; at end of ramp take a left; travel approximately 1/4 mile. Rink is on the left.
- From the South. Take 93 North to exit 14 in Concord; at the end of the ramp take a right; travel approximately 1/4 mile. Rink is on left.

FRANKLIN PIERCE UNIVERSITY

Directions from Maine

Take I-95 South to Portsmouth, NH and connect to Route 101 West
Follow Route 101 West for ~ 1 ½ hours to Peterborough, NH where you will connect to Route 202 South/West
Take a left onto Route 202 South/West, follow through Jaffrey, NH and continue to intersection of Route 119
Take a right at the light onto Route 119 West
Travel ~1 ½ miles to the college (entrance will be on your right at the blinking yellow light)

Directions from Boston

Take Route 128 (I-95) North/South to Route 2 West (Concord Rotary)
Follow Route 2 West to Route 140 North (Gardner, MA)
Take Route 140 North to Route 12 North (Winchendon, MA – You will travel 12 North for ~2 miles)
Turn right onto Route 202 North/East
Follow Route 202 North/East across the state line into Rindge, NH
At the third stop light in Rindge, turn left onto Route 119 West
Travel ~1 ½ miles to the college (entrance will be on your right at the blinking yellow light)

FRANKLIN PIERCE UNIVERSITY

Continued...

Directions from Logan Airport, Boston

Take the Expressway (thru tunnel) to Route 95 North (Rte 128) to Route 2 West (Concord Rotary)

Follow Route 2 West to Route 140 North (Gardner, MA)

Take Route 140 North to Route 12 North (Winchendon, MA – You will travel 12 North for ~2 miles)

Turn right onto Route 202 North/East

Follow Route 202 North/East across the state line into Rindge, NH

At the third stop light in Rindge, turn left onto Route 119 West

Travel ~1 ½ miles to the college (entrance will be on your right at the blinking yellow light)

Directions from Manchester Airport, Manchester, NH

Exit the airport and at the traffic light, take a right onto Route 3A (follow to Route 101 West)

Take Route 101 West to Peterborough, NH where you will connect to Route 202 South/West

Take Route 202 South/West through Jaffrey, NH and continue to intersection of Route 119

Take a right at the light onto Route 119 West

Travel ~1 ½ miles to the college (entrance will be on your right at the blinking yellow light)

*Though these are the most direct directions, please refer to an atlas for alternate routes

GILL STADIUM, MANCHESTER, NH

Take I-93 to exit 8 (Bridge Street) take Bridge Street all the way to Beech Street.

Take a left onto Beech. The stadium is about ¼ of a mile down Beech Street at the intersection with Valley Street.

HOLMAN STADIUM, NASHUA, NH

Holman Stadium is on 67 Amherst Street in Nashua, NH

From Everett Turnpike (RT 3), take exit 7E onto Amherst Street. Holman Stadium is approximately one mile on the left.

JFK MEMORIAL COLISEUM, MANCHESTER, NH

From the East: Rt-101 west to I-93 north. I-93 to Wellington Rd/Bridge St exit 8. (It is the first exit once on I-93 north.) Bear right at the end of the ramp. You are now on Wellington Rd which turns into Bridge St. Go straight thru two sets of lights (1st set is I-93 south exit ramp; 2nd set is Wellington/Mammoth intersection). Continue straight (you will go up a hill and down the other side). Then you will come to a light (Christy's store/gas station) at Maple St. and continue straight (you are now on Bridge St.). At the next light (Beech St.) turn left (one-way street). Keep to the left, and go approx. 1/2 mile to JFK Coliseum. Arena is on the left side of the road.

From the I-93: I-93 south to Wellington Rd/Bridge St exit 8. (It is the first exit once on I-93 north.) Bear right at the end of the ramp. You are now on Wellington Rd which turns into Bridge St. Go straight thru two sets of lights (1st set is I-93 south exit ramp; 2nd set is Wellington/Mammoth intersection). Continue straight (you will go up a hill and down the other side). Then you will come to a light (Christy's store/gas station) at Maple St. and continue straight (you are now on Bridge St.). At the next light (Beech St.) turn left (one-way street). Keep to the left, and go approx. 1/2 mile to JFK Coliseum. Arena is on the left side of the road.

From the South: If coming from I-93 take exit 8 (Wellington Rd/Bridge St and follow directions above from I-93).

From Rt-3: Everett Turnpike (Rt-3) take Rt-293/101 east to South Willow St exit (same exit as Mall of NH). At end of the exit ramp bear left onto South Willow and back over the highway. South Willow is also Rt-28. Stay on So. Willow and follow the Rt-28 signs to South Maple St on the right. South Maple turns into Maple (both are Rt-28 north). JFK Coliseum is on the left side of the road, just after you pass Gill Stadium (baseball/football).

From the West: Rt-293/101 east and follow directions "From Rt-3" above.

LACONIA MIDDLE SCHOOL

From the South:

- I-93 to Exit 20
- At exit 20, take ramp right for RT-132 / RT-11 / US-3 toward Tilton / Laconia.
- Turn left onto US-3 / RT-11 / RT-132 / Laconia Rd
- Pass Wendy's.
- Keep straight onto RT-11A / Daniel Webster Hwy
- Turn left onto RT-106 / Main St
- Arrive at 915 N Main St, Laconia, NH 03246
- The last intersection is Folsom St. If you reach Busiel St, you've gone too far.

From the North:

- I-93 South to Exit 23
- At exit 23, take ramp right for RT-104 toward New Hampton / Meredith
- Turn left onto RT-104 / RT-132 / Bristol-Meredith Rd
- Keep straight onto RT-104 / Bristol-Meredith Rd
- Turn right onto Pease Rd
- Bear right onto RT-106 / Parade Rd
- Arrive at 915 N Main St, Laconia, NH 03246
- The last intersection is Busiel St. If you reach Folsom St, you've gone too far.

LIVINGSTON PARK - MANCHESTER, NH

- Take I-89 South to end, then I-93 South.
- After the tollbooth bear right and stay on 93 South.
- Take Exit 9S (Route 28 South).
- Follow for about 1.5 miles.
- Livingston Park is on the right.
- There is a long wrought iron black fence around the park.

MANCHESTER MEMORIAL FIELD – MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL

From the North – Take I-93S to I-293/101W. Exit at Exit 1 (So. Willow St.). Take a left onto So. Willow St. Drive North for 0.4 miles, and take a right onto Weston Rd. After 0.3 miles you bear right at the light and Memorial will be on the left.

From the South – Take I-93 North to I-293/101W. Exit at Exit 1 (So. Willow St.). Take a right onto So. Willow St. Drive North for 0.4 miles, and take a right onto Weston Rd. After 0.3 miles you bear right at the light and Memorial will be on the left.

From the East - Take 101W. 101W merges onto I-93 S. Stay on I-93 S to I-293/101W. Exit at Exit 1 (So. Willow St.). Take a right onto So. Willow St. Drive North for 0.4 miles, and take a right onto Weston Rd. After 0.3 miles you bear right at the light and Memorial will be on the left.

From the West - Take 101E. 101E will merge to 293. Exit at Exit 1(So. Willow St.). Take a left ont So. Willow St. Drive North for 0.5 miles, and take a right onto Weston Rd. After 0.3 miles you bear right at the light and Memorial will be on the left.

MEMORIAL FIELD, CONCORD, NH

This is not the shortest route, but it is the easiest and most direct. If you are in the city and need to ask directions, anyone can tell you where the field is, or look for Concord High School - the field is just down the street.

- **From the south:** Approach Concord on Interstate 93, just south of the city, take Interstate 89N toward Hanover/Lebanon. Go 1-2 miles to Exit 2 (Clinton St.). Turn right on Clinton St., go approximately 1 mile to the first light. At that light, turn left on Fruit St. Memorial Field is 300 yds on the left.
- **From the west or northwest:** Approach Concord on Interstate 89S. Get off at Exit 2 (Clinton St.). Turn right on Clinton St., go approximately 1 mile to the first light. At that light, turn left on Fruit St. Memorial Field is 300 yds on the left.
- **From the north:** Approach Concord on I-93, go past the city exits to I-89N then take Exit 2 (Clinton St.). Turn right on Clinton St., go approximately 1 mile to the first light. At that light, turn left on Fruit St. Memorial Field is 300 yds on the left.

Parking

There is parking in the lot at Memorial Field, or across the street on the State Hospital grounds* within the areas marked with ropes, or on either side of Fruit Street.

- *Parking at the State Hospital grounds is provided through the generosity of the State of New Hampshire*

NORTHEAST DELTA DENTAL STADIUM – MANCHESTER, NH

From the North and South via I-93

Take I-93 South to I-293 South. Follow I-293S and take Exit #6. As you follow the exit, bear right and stay to the right as you follow the wide turn around until it intersects with the Amoskeag Bridge (the Ramada Inn will be on the right). Turn right onto the bridge, stay to the right as you go over the river, then exit to the right onto the Canal Street ramp. Follow Canal St. until it intersects with Granite St. Take a right onto Granite St. and immediately move into the left lane. At light take a left on South Commercial Street. Please follow the brown FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

From the East

Follow Route 101 heading west to I-93 South. Go about half a mile and stay right, exiting onto I-293 North (right hand exit off I-93S - this exit is not numbered). Once on I-293N, go past the Mall of NH and Brown Avenue (airport) exits. After crossing the river, stay to the right as I-293N bears right. Follow I-293N and take Exit #5 (Granite Street). Turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto Granite Street. Take a right onto South Commercial Street. Please follow the brown FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

From Route 3 (Everett Turnpike)

Follow Route 3 to the Everett Turnpike heading north. Just south of Manchester, this road becomes I-293 North. Follow I-293N and take Exit 5 (Granite Street). Turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto Granite Street. Take a right onto South Commercial Street. Please follow the brown FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

One other option we strongly recommend is to get off at Exit 4 and follow the signs to the new ballpark via Elm Street. This will help avoid traffic congestion on 293.

From the West

Take Route 101 East to Route 293 North. Follow I-293N and Take Exit 5 (Granite Street). Turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto Granite Street. Take a right onto South Commercial Street. Please follow the brown FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

MERRIMACK VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL

I 93 North or South: Take Exit 17 West; Merge onto US-4 and travel 1.1 miles; Turn LEFT onto TREMONT ST. – US Rt. 3; Turn LEFT onto COMMUNITY DR.; Follow Community Dr. to the end.; High School faces you at the intersection. Merrimack Valley Middle School is to your left. Parking is available in front of school and on either side.

I 89: At I 93/89 intersection in Bow take the I 93N exit. Take Exit 17w and follow the above directions.

From the Seacoast: Travel as you would to Concord and connect to I 93N . Take Exit 17w and follow above directions.

MILFORD HIGH SCHOOL

From the North:

Rte.13 South to center of Milford, west on Elm St, left at 1st stop light onto West St., school 3/4 Th. of mile on left.

From the South:

Rte. 13 North, left onto Union St. (after going under Rte. 101), left at stop sign onto Osgood Rd., go by Middle School on right, take right onto West Street, High School 1/2 mi. on right

From East or West:

take Rte. 101 to Rte 13 exit, proceed North on 13 toward Milford, take 1st left on Union and follow directions for arriving From the South

NASHUA HIGH SCHOOL SOUTH

From North:

Route 3 to Exit 5W

Take right at the light

Police Station on the right – take right onto Riverside Drive

Continue until you get to High School, on the left

From South:

Route 3 to Exit 5W

Go over the highway, continue straight

Police Station on the right – take right onto Riverside Drive

Continue until you get to High School, on the left

PINKERTON ACADEMY, DERRY, NH

1. From 93 South/North to exit 4 (Rt. 102 Derry/Londonderry)
2. End of exit ramp head east.
3. Go through 2 sets of lights
4. After second set of lights follow for approx. 1 mile through downtown (Hoodcroft Golf Course will be on right)
5. When you come to a rotary (circle) go around the circle and take the 4th exit off. (make almost a complete circle) This will be By-Pass 28 North.
6. Go straight up the hill. Pinkerton Academy will be on the left hand side.
7. Park in front of The Pinkerton Building (with clock tower)
8. Facing that building: on left is another building connected to it by a covered walkway.
9. Enter the left hand building from under the walkway.
10. If you get messed up just ask anyone for the main office.
11. Main office is on right as soon as you enter

PLYMOUTH STATE UNIVERSITY, PLYMOUTH, NH

PE Center for volleyball, basketball, softball, baseball and tennis games/matches

I-93 north and south

Exit 25, turn right and right again onto Fieldhouse Rd.

From the east

Rt. 3 to I-93 north, then follow above

From the west

Rt. 25 to Tenney Mtn. Highway to I-93 south, then follow above

RINKS AT EXETER, EXETER, NH

Only 25 Minutes from Manchester!

From North/West (Manchester Area) Route 101 East to Exit 9, Route 27, Exeter. At end of ramp turn right on to Route 27(Epping Road.) Half a mile down, take first left onto Industrial Drive. The Rink is the First driveway on left.

Only 15 Minutes from the Massachusetts border!

From South/East (NH Seacoast Area) Take I-95 to Exit 2. Take Route 101 West to Exit 9, Route 27, Exeter. Turn left at the stop sign at the end of ramp onto Route 27 East. Half a mile down, take first left onto Industrial Drive. The Rink is the first driveway on left.

ST. ANSELM'S COLLEGE - MANCHESTER, NH

- Take I-89 South to end then I-93 South.
- After toll booth stay straight on I-293 thru Manchester (along the river) to Exit 3 (Bedford, Macy's).
- Bear right off ramp onto Rt. 101 West, go straight to first traffic light.
- At the light which is the intersection of Routes 101 and 114 go straight across to Route 114 toward Goffstown.
- In about two miles on Rt. 114 you will see a sign to take a right turn for St. Anselm's College.
- Take right turn, then go straight.
- College is on the right, parking is to the rear.

SOUTHERN NEW HAMPSHIRE UNIVERSITY, MANCHESTER, NH

Directions from Boston (1 hour)

From I-93 take exit 9N onto US3/RT 28 heading north. At the first intersection, go left onto West Alice Drive, which becomes Donati Drive at the sharp curve. Follow Donati to the end, then go right onto Bicentennial Drive. Follow Bicentennial to the stop sign, then take a right onto North River Road. The university is 1/4 mile on the left.

From Hartford, CT (2 1/2 hours)

I-84E to I-90E to I-495N to I-93N. In New Hampshire, take exit 9N. Proceed as above.

From Worcester, MA (1 1/4 hours)

I-290 to I-495N to I-93N. Proceed as above.

From New Jersey (5 to 6 hours)

George Washington Bridge in New York City take I-95N to I-91N to I-84E in Hartford, CT to I-90E to I-495N to I-93N. In New Hampshire, take exit 9N. Proceed as above.

From New York City (4 - 4 1/2 hours)

I-95N in New York then same as New Jersey.

From Bangor, ME (5 hours)

I-95S (Maine Turnpike) to Portsmouth, NH to Route 101W to I-93N to exit 9N. Proceed as above.

Directions from the South

(Everett Turnpike/Route 3)

Take US Route 3 to I-293 North to Exit 6. Cross the Amoskeag Bridge, then turn left onto Elm Street. Follow Elm for 1 mile, then turn left onto Bennington Road. Go 1 block, then right onto North River Road. The university is 1.5 miles on the left.

From the North (I-93)

Take I-93S to exit 9N. Drive North on US Route 3/Rt 28, as above.

- I 93 S

- Exit 5W
- Rt at bottom of ramp
- Right at lights and follow signs to Stellos Stadium

Traveling by Car

From Boston, MA:



Take I-95 North to Exit 4 (NH Lakes and Mountains, Spaulding Turnpike). Continue North to Exit 6W and follow Route 4 West past the UNH/Durham Route 108 exit. Exit at Route 155A and turn east toward Durham. Follow 155A past a short stretch of fields to the UNH Athletic Fields and Fieldhouse. Ample parking is available in "A Lot" directly across from the Field House (**before 6pm park at the Visitors Lot next to A lot**). You will see signs for "A Lot" parking prior to arriving at the Fieldhouse. The Whittemore Center, home to ice hockey and basketball is only a short walk from "A Lot", as well as the Fieldhouse.

From Portland, ME:

Follow I-95 South to Exit 5. Continue on Spaulding Turnpike North to Exit 6W and follow Route 4 West. Follow directions as listed from Boston.

From Concord, NH:

Take Route 4 East to the 155A exit. Follow directions as listed from Boston.

From Manchester, NH:

Take Route 101 to Epping; go north on Route 125 to the Lee Traffic Circle. Drive East on Route 4 to the Route 155A exit. Follow directions as listed from Boston.

WEST MEMORIAL FIELD, MANCHESTER HIGH SCHOOL WEST

When heading north on 293N, take exit 5, Granite Street Bridge. Turn left onto Granite Street. Go through several traffic lights. Turn right on Main Street. The school sits two blocks up on the left. The gym is by Conant Street; the playing field for football, field hockey and soccer is on the right from Main Street. Turn right for parking next to the field.

When traveling south on 293 take exit number 6 towards Amoskeag Bridge. Keep left at the fork in the ramp. turn left onto Eddy Road. This becomes McGregor Street which then becomes Main Street. You will go past a bank, grocery store and a hospital. Just past the hospital is West. The school and gym will be on your right, with the gym off Conant Street. The playing field for football, field hockey and soccer is on the left. Turn left for parking at the field.

From the South/West

Take I-93 north to exit 20. Turn left at lights and take Route 3/11 east to Laconia. Follow for approximately 8 miles to the intersection of Route 106, take a left and go north through downtown Laconia. Go approximately 2.5 miles, pass the prison on the left, at the next set of lights, take a left onto Meredith Center Road. The field is on the left.

From the East

Take Route 11 West through Alton to Route 11A West. Go past Gunstock and through Gilford into Laconia. Take left onto Union Ave pass RiteAide, and then bear right onto Church St. At the second set of lights take a right onto No. Main St. / Rte 106 No. Main St. Go approximately 2.5 miles, pass the prison on the left, at the next set of lights, and take a left onto Meredith Center Road. The field is on the left.

From the North

Take Route 93 south to exit 23. Take Route 104 east for about 5 miles to Meredith Center Road. Take a right onto Meredith Center Road (follow NH Humane Society signs). Follow Meredith Center Road for about 5 miles. The field will be on the right.

STRIKERS EAST BOWLING LANES

FROM THE EAST --- Take the best route to Rt. 101 west towards Manchester. Take exit 5 (Raymond) off Rt. 101. Make a right off the exit and proceed to the 2nd set of lights. Make a right onto Essex Drive, were 1/10 of a mile down on the left side.

FROM THE WEST --- Take your best route to Interstate 101 East. Follow 101 East to exit 5 (Raymond). Take a right off the exit and proceed to the 2nd set of lights. Make a right on to Essex Drive, were 1/10 of a mile on the left side.

FROM THE NORTH AND SOUTH --- Take best route to Interstate 93, then to RT 101 East EXIT 7 off 93 and follow the above directions from the west.

VERIZON WIRELESS ARENA

From the North:

Take I-93S to Route 293.

- Take exit 6.
- Exit will circle around and over the Amoskeag Bridge.
- Stay right and take the Canal Street ramp.
- Follow Canal Street for about 1 mile (8 sets of lights) to Granite Street (bus station is on your left).
- Turn left onto Granite Street.
- The arena will be just ahead on the right.

From Boston and Points South:

- Take I-93N.
- Approaching Manchester, take Route 293N (left hand exit).
- After Brown Avenue exit, stay to the right as Route 293 bears right.
- Take exit 5(Granite Street Exit).
- Turn right at the bottom of the ramp.
- The arena will be just ahead on the right.

From the Seacoast:

- Go west on Route 101W/I-93S to Route 293N.
- Take exit 5(Granite Street Exit).
- Turn right at the bottom of the ramp.
- The arena will be just ahead on the right.

From the West:

- Take Route 101E to Route 293N.
- Take exit 5(Granite Street Exit).
- Turn right at the bottom of the ramp.
- The arena will be just ahead on the right.

Alternate Routes:

- Patrons traveling on I-93 may also use the Hanover Street exit to Elm Street.
- Take a left onto Elm Street.
- The Arena will be down on the left at the corner of Lake Avenue and Elm Street.
- *Patrons coming down Route 293 from the North may bypass the Canal Street ramp and continue just ahead to Elm Street. Take a right onto Elm Street and continue to the arena located at the corner of Lake Avenue and Elm Street.
