

BY-LAW ARTICLE XXV

Indoor Track

Boys and Girls

Sect. 1: Indoor Track shall be administered by the Indoor Track Committee of the NHIAA and the rules of the National Federation will govern the sport when applicable.

Sect. 2: State Championships

- A. Only NHIAA member schools may enter the State Championships.
- B. Only athletes, who have met, in meet competition, one (1) or more of the qualifying standards, are eligible to be entered in the meets. For an athlete to compete in the State Championships, he/she must have participated in at least one (1) indoor track meet during the regular season.
- C. A competitor may participate in four (4) events.
- D. Point scoring will be 10, 8, 6, 4, 2, 1
- E. There will be a minimum of 12 performers in each event, based upon performances, as determined by the Indoor Track Committee.

Sect. 3: Awards:

Official NHIAA championship and runner-up plaques will be awarded to the respective champion and runner-up teams in each State Championship (boys and girls) and the six (6) place winners in all events, including relays, will receive individual medals.

Sect. 4: State Records

Performances in the NHIAA or New England Council Championship Meet (s) or regular scheduled New Hampshire Indoor Track league meets will be considered for a record. Requirements for consideration: for running events, fully automatic timing (FAT), for field events: total station for laser measurement or steel tape must be used to record the official performance. The Meet Director and Head Official at the meet in question will confirm the performance. Coaches must submit the appropriate form, as found in the Policy and Procedures Manual, for record consideration. Indoor Track State Records must be certified by the NHIAA Indoor Track Committee. Sect. 5: Divisional Alignment

Indoor Track shall be aligned in two (2) divisions based upon enrollments and petitions subject to the approval of the Classification Committee.
